**Ex 24:3-8:** The Israelites promised to observe all the prescriptions of the Lord as related by Moses. To seal this promise Moses offered a sacrifice to the Lord and sprinkled the people with blood offering.

<u>Heb 9:11-15</u>: Jesus came as high priest, not offering the blood of animals but His own blood, to achieve eternal redemption. Jesus is the mediator of the new covenant.

Mk 14:12-16, 22-26: Jesus gave instructions for the Passover supper. At this meal He took the bread and wine and changed it into His Body and Blood and gave this Eucharist to His disciples. They all ate and drank at Jesus's request.

<u>Today's Message -</u> Moses ratifies the covenant by offering a Thanksgiving sacrifice and by sprinkling blood over the people. The new covenant, the law's oblation, is ratified in the blood of Christ, the unblemished offering poured out for us.
