Eph 5:21-32: Paul gives specific directives to wives and husbands. Wives are to be submissive to their husbands as the Church submits to Christ. Husbands must love their wives as their own bodies. They are to be ever faithful to each other.

<u>Jn 6:60-69</u>: Jesus emphasizes that to believe in Him demands faith—a gift from His Father. Many left Jesus, but His twelve turned and said, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You alone have the words of eternal life."

<u>Today's Message</u> - Joshua confronts the tribes of Israel: Will you desert your covenant with Yahweh? The desertion of disciples is a prelude to the paschal mystery. With Peter, however, let us profess our faith in the Lord, who gave himself up for us all.
