Pallottines (The Society of the
Catholic Apostolate) is a religious community of over 2300

was founded in Rome in 1835 by St. Vincent Pallotti. He is
considered the pioneer in championing the role of the Laity in
the mission of the Church. He is recognized as having
profoundly influenced teaching of Vat. II on Laity. The motto of
the Society is: "make everyone a Catholic, every Catholic a
good Catholic, and every good Catholic an Apostle". He always
reminded people that they are called to be apostles no matter

OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIPS - Some scholarships are available for students who are currently attending a Reading public school and would like to transfer to Saint Catharine of Siena School. In order to qualify, the family's income must meet the requirements of the EITC-OSTC.

Pre-Kindergarten - St. Catharine's Pre-Kindergarten (four-year old program) is located in the school building.
