It was founded in Rome in 1835 by St. Vincent Pallotti. He is considered the pioneer in championing the role of the Laity in the mission of the Church. He is recognized as having profoundly influenced teaching of Vatican II on Laity. The motto of the Society is: "make everyone a Catholic, every Catholic a good Catholic, and every good Catholic an Apostle". He always reminded people that they are called to be apostles no matter where they are and what they do.
