BISHOP-ELECT SCHLERT'S ORDINATION / INSTALLATION INFORMATION

In celebration of the Ordination and Installation of Bishop-elect Alfred Schlert as the Fifth Bishop of Allentown, the Diocese will be having two liturgical services:

Solemn Vespers at which the Bishop-elect will make a Profession of Faith and the Oath of Fidelity is scheduled for Wednesday, August 30 at 7:00 PM at the Cathedral of Saint Catharine of Siena in Allentown (1825 Turner Street, Allentown, PA. 18104). This event is open to the public. As the Allentown Fair will be occurring, all parking will be at St. Thomas More Church (1040 Flexer Avenue, Allentown, PA. 18105). Continuous shuttles will be running beginning at 5:00 PM. Light refreshments in the Parish Activity Center will follow and everyone will have a chance to greet the Bishop-Elect.

The **Mass of Ordination** will be held at the Cathedral of Saint Catharine of Siena on Thursday, August 31 at 2:00 PM. Because of space limitations at the Cathedral, attendance at this event is by invitation only. The Ordination/Installation will be broadcast live on Service Electric and Blue Ridge Cable TV locally. OUR 2017 MISSION CO-OP APPEAL

Rev. M. S. Selva Raj, Mission Director for the Diocese of Kumbakonam, India will speak at all the Masses on the weekend of August 19th and 20th. This diocese has an area of 7823 sq. km and is situated in Tami Nadu, South India with a Catholic population of 2, 13,000 which is just about 6 % of the total population. It is served by 200 diocesan and 73 religious priests, 568 nuns and 15 trained lay catechists. We educate over 2000 very poor orphan children from remote villages every year by providing them with free board and lodge. This project is 80% dependent on MCP funds each year. Every year an average of 60 young men and women go out of this diocese to another mission throughout India and other parts of the world to serve God and His people as missionaries. The mission and spiritual prospects of Kumbakonam Diocese are bright but its needs are many and pressing. 60% of its Catholics are depressingly poor. Therefore, your fervent prayers and generous help are earnestly requested for building the Kingdom of God, in and through the Diocese of Kumbakonam, India.

SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

1 Kgs 3:5,7-12: Solomon prays for wisdom to lead the people of God. God is pleased that Solomon asked above all else to know right from wrong. God promises him wisdom and understanding that will be unequalled either in times past or in the future.

Mt 13:44-52: Jesus compares the value of the Kingdom of God to a hidden treasure, to a most valuable pearl, to a dragnet. It is beyond human comprehension but in the end God's angels will sort out those who have lived good lives from the unrepentant sinners.

Today's Message - The person of true wisdom, like Solomon, will seek the reign of God and treasure it above all else. It is more precious than gold and silver. Thus one becomes conformed to the image of Christ, the Son.

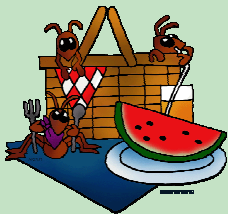
