Our parish family of St. Catharine of Siena and St. Mary's joyfully thank God for the great gift of our Lady's apparitions in Fatima, Portugal. The closeness of our Lady to us and her call to return to the Gospel through prayer, sacrifice and conversion are as important for us today as they were in 1917. To mark the 100th Anniversary of the Fatima apparitions, our parish family will host an Evening of Prayer on Wednesday, September 13, 2017 in the Chapel on Perkiomen Avenue at 7 p.m. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on the altar for a Holy Hour. During that time, the Rosary and Fatima Litany will be prayed. The Holy Hour will conclude at 8 p.m. with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Confessions will be heard throughout the Holy Hour. Everyone is welcome.

Once again, this Fall, we have the opportunity for daily Eucharistic Adoration in the Chapel (Perkiomen Avenue).
