THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Wis 1:13-15;2:23-24: God does not rejoice in the destruction of the living. Rather God formed human beings to be imperishable, and if we practice justice we will live forever.

2 Cor 8:7,9, 13-15: Christians should be generous to others in imitation of the sovereign liberality of Christ who gave His life for the salvation of all.
