In God's Providence, the Jubilee also is taking place during the <u>60th Anniversary of</u> <u>the founding of the Diocese</u> and the Year of St. Joseph who, with Mary, lived each day in the Real Presence of Jesus. Joseph was the first protector of the Real Presence, and we seek his intercession in our efforts as a Roman Catholic Family of Faith to center our diocesan life on the Holy Eucharist each day. Acts 10:25-26, 34-35, 44-48: Peter visits Cornelius and his family. God will favor anyone who acts uprightly, Jews, and Gentiles alike. He gave orders that all who believe should be baptized.

1 Jn 4:7-10: Christians should love one another as God Himself is love. A person without love does not know God. Love is that God has sent His Son as an offering for sin.

Jn 15:9-17: Jesus admonishes His disciples to continue the love He has shown to them. The keeping of the commandments will prove this. "You are to love one another ... it was I who chose you."

Today's Message: Let us love one another as Christ has loved us by offering Himself for our sins. His love is to be revealed to all the world, as Peter himself taught.


We are in need of adult and youth (grades 6 - 12) volunteers to help run the program. This is a great opportunity for service hours!
