Fr. William Garrott, OP was born and raised in Hagerstown, Maryland. He is the youngest of eight children. Father received a bachelor of science in chemistry from Mount St. Mary's University in

Emmitsburg, MD and a master's degree in spiritual theology from the Angelicum in Rome. Fr. Bill entered the Order of Preachers in 1988 and was ordained for the Dominicans in 1994.
