





Catholic Trivia Answer: A.

June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, celebrated on June 16th in 2023. In 1675, Jesus told St. Margaret, a French Visitation Nun, that He wanted the Feast of the Sacred Heart to be celebrated on the Friday after the Corpus Christi octave. In the 11th Century, Christians often meditated on the Five Wounds of Jesus, and the specific devotion to the Sacred Heart came from this meditation.
