

Catholic Trivia ANSWER: C. St. Peter and Paul's day is the feast day that honors the martyrdom of the two saints. While the church recognizes that they may not have died on the same day, they are believed to have been killed in Rome by Emperor Nero on June 29<sup>th</sup> in 67 AD. Peter was crucified head down at his own request. Paul was a Roman citizen and, therefore, could not be crucified according to Roman law. He was beheaded. The Church unites them in a common celebration on June 29th and gives them identical honour. It is honored across the world, but is only a major holiday in Rome. Schools, banks and stores are closed, as well as the Vatican, and the city is full of both religious and secular celebrations. The Pope holds a mass in which he gives a pallium—a special vestment worn over the shoulders-to archbishops appointed in the past year.
