    - Book Review sessions were held by Father Miller and Deacon Stapleton to discuss the books that were distributed at Christmas.
    - About 54 people attended the Marriage Renewal and Valentine Dinner.
    - Millions of Monica's began in January. More advertisements are planned to encourage others to join in the prayers.
    - A 7Sisters ministry is being coordinated to pray Holy Hours for Father Miller and Father JV.
    - Social Sundays are scheduled March 6<sup>th</sup> Ancient Order of Hiberians; April 27<sup>th</sup> – St. Vincent DePaul; May (date TBD) – 60 + Club; June 6<sup>th</sup> – Cursillo; and September 7<sup>th</sup> – Knights of Columbus
    - The "5000 Blankets" movie and dinner night went well with about 50 people attending and 39 blankets donated to the Salvation Army.
