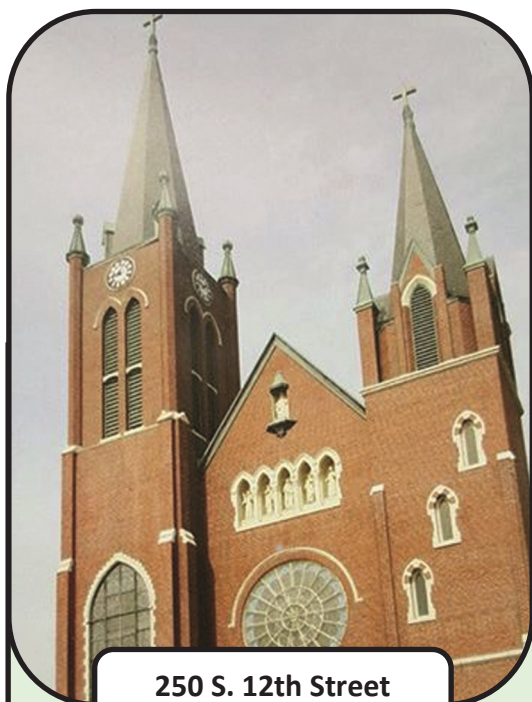

As the Diocese of Allentown celebrates its 65th Jubilee Year, Bishop Schlert invites every parishioner of Saint Catharine's & St. Mary's to join him in a diocesan-wide Eucharistic Consecration — a journey to deepen our love for Jesus, truly present in the Most Holy Eucharist.

Beginning Tuesday, May 5, we will spend 33 days in prayer with *33 Days to Eucharistic Glory* by Matthew Kelly, leading to our Consecration on Sunday, June 7, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. 
