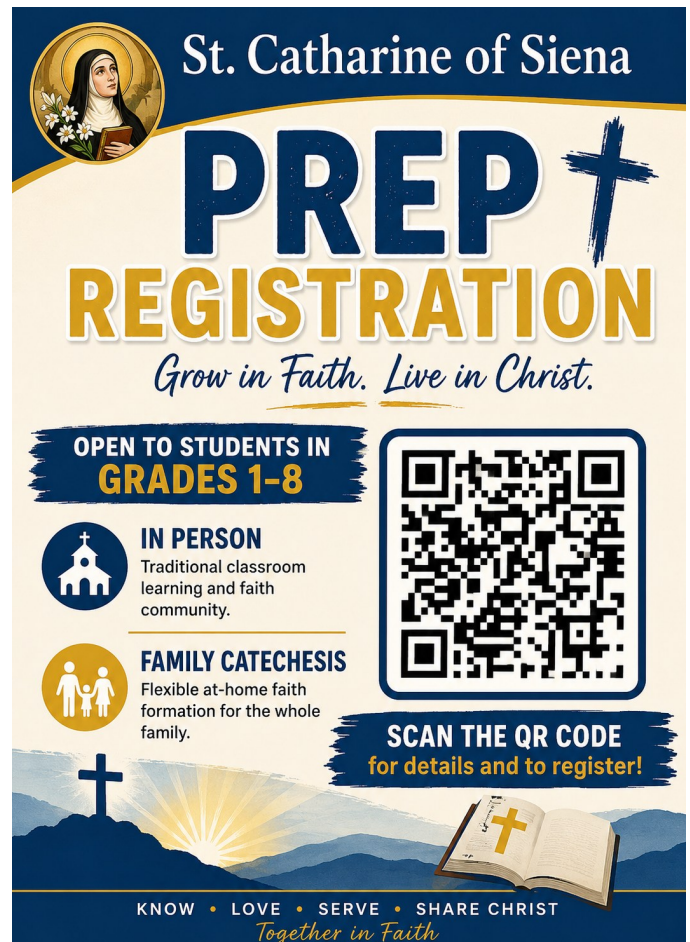
HELP RESTORE ST. MARY'S R.C. CHURCH

St. Mary's Church has been the hub of the Polish Community since it was built in 1888. In its younger days, St. Mary's membership was one of the largest in the County. With the outgrowth of Catholic Churches across Berks County, our Catholic denomination has spread to all including the outer reaches of the County, leaving St. Mary's as a smaller but strong, vibrant and resilient congregation. Costs have gone up substantially while the congregation size at St. Mary's has diminished, requiring new sources of financial support. On Monday, September 14, 2026, from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., a fund raising dinner will be held at the YR Club, 1019 Thrush Road, Wyomissing, PA. 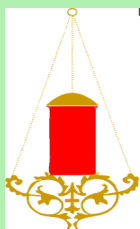
